JOB SUMMARY:

The Savannah River Site is a key Department of Energy (DOE) industrial complex dedicated to environmental management and cleanup, nuclear weapons stockpile stewardship, and nuclear materials disposition in support of the U.S. nuclear non-proliferation efforts. The site also develops and deploys technologies to support the environmental cleanup and energy independence.

The site's center is approximately 23 miles southeast of Augusta, Georgia, and 20 miles south of Aiken, South Carolina, the two closest population centers. There are more than 1,000 facilities at the site concentrated in only 10 percent of the total land area.
